International Childhood Cancer Day (ICCD) 2006



Every year, about 120 children are newly diagnosed with cancer in Singapore. Of these new cases, children between 0 and 6 years old amount to 46% of the Children's Cancer Foundation's caseload. Launched in Singapore on 15 Feb 2005, the objective of ICCD was to raise awareness of childhood cancer in Singapore by introducing the gold ribbon (an official ribbon for childhood cancer around the world). This year, the tagline is "Every link makes us stronger". Members of the public are encouraged to wear the gold ribbon pin on **15 February 2006** to support the cause.
