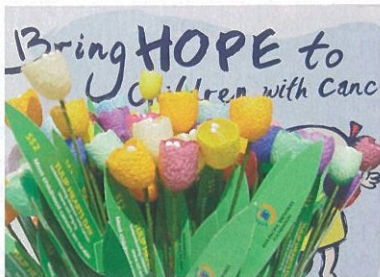


Buy a Tulip Heart

The common forms of cancer afflicting children include leukemia and brain tumour. When a child is affected, the family is devastated. This means volunteers and staff at the CCF have to provide emotional support for the families as well. The CCF runs two Family Support Centres at KK Women's and Children's Hospital and the National University Hospital. It needs an average of \$2.5 million annually to carry out its work.
